- CD's, Audiobooks, DVDs

We cannot accept:

- **Damaged books with broken bindings, missing pages, soiled, musty, moldy, with smoke or water damage, or with writing in the text**
- Outdated materials
- Toys, games, puzzles, artwork
- Reader's Digest books
- Professional journals
- Encyclopedias
- Computer programs
- Cassette or VHS tapes

Frequently Asked Questions

Where do I go to donate my books and other items?

Donations of books will be accepted at the front desk of the Brownell Library during library hours. There is a limit of 2 boxes per day.

How much can I claim as a charitable donation?

We do not determine the value of the donation. Receipts can be provided designating how many paperbacks and hardbacks were donated. Please count your books and have a total ready when you donate.

What happens to the items I donate?

Books may be added to the library's collection, put into the Friends of the Brownell Library booksale, or sent to Better World Books, a self-sustaining, for-profit social venture whose mission is to capitalize on the value of the book to fund literacy initiatives locally, nationally and around the world.
