F BROWN Brown, John Gregory. **A thousand miles from nowhere: a novel / Little, Brown and Company, 2016**

“Former high school English teacher Henry Garrett is not just fleeing Katrina-devastated New Orleans. He's running from a life he abandoned months before in a string of poor decisions. His job, home, and wife are gone. The Garrett paternal line is rife with mental illness, and Henry himself is slipping away. Days after Katrina hits, Henry finds himself at the Ganesha Motel in a small northwestern Virginia town, unsure of whether he should try to reclaim his estranged wife, who is living somewhere nearby, or seek refuge at his sister's home in Baltimore. Neither woman is likely to welcome him with open arms. A tragic accident with far-reaching implications grounds Henry at the motel as he's forced to sort out his life's purpose while confronting familial ghosts. Brown's meditative novel is steeped in melancholy musical references from many genres. painter, and a four-year-old boy, who is now the last remaining member of an immensely wealthy and powerful media mogul's family. With chapters weaving between the aftermath of the crash and the backstories of the passengers and crew members--including a Wall Street titan and his wife, a Texan-born party boy just in from London, a young woman questioning her path in life, and a career pilot--the mystery surrounding the tragedy heightens.
